Dear Future First Grade Families,

We are looking forward to meeting all of you and having a fun and exciting 2018-2019 school year. If possible we would like you to bring some supplies with you when you come to school on the first day. Most of these items will be put into classroom containers to be used by all of the students throughout the school year.

We request specific brands because we have found that these work best and last the longest for school use.

Please **DO NOT label** the following items as they will be shared in community areas:

1. 1 box of Crayola thick markers
2. 1 box of Crayola thin markers
3. 1 pack of Crayola Twistable Crayons (not mini please)
4. 1 box of 24 Crayola colored pencils
5. 1 box of **sharpened** (please) Ticonderoga pencils
6. 1-3 pack of Paper-Mate white pearl premium erasers
7. A pack of thick glue sticks
8. Expo low odor chisel tip dry-eraser markers assorted primary colors 4pk (black, blue, red, green)
9. 5 individual bags of Gallon and Quart size ziplock bags
10. Scotch tape
11. Koss (TM-602) Headphones (NO EARBUDS)
12. 2 plain two pocket folders 1 green, 1 yellow
13. 1 blue poly 2 pocket folder
14. One heavy duty plastic two pocket folder to be kept in the backpack for notices.
15. 1 box of facial tissue
16. 1 box of plain band-aids (no designs or characters please)
17. One roll of paper towels
18. 1 White, 1 inch thick, 3 ring binder

**Items to be labeled:**

- A backpack to be brought to school every day that is large enough to fit folders and library books.

**Snacks**

Each child should bring a **healthy** snack each day, including half-days. Cheese, fruit, vegetables, yogurt and crackers are some good suggestions. Due to nut allergies, please try to avoid peanut butter and any other nuts. Candy and soda are not allowed.

**Shoes**

Please do not send your child to school in backless, open-toed shoes: crocs, flip flops, clogs, etc. They are not safe and are not allowed on or around the playground structure.
