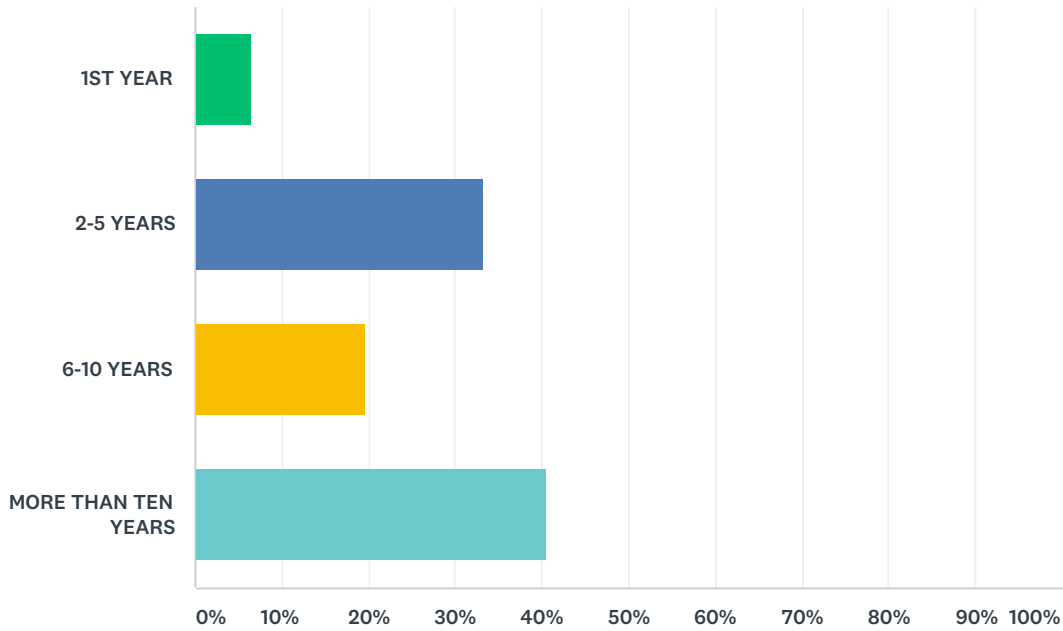


# Q1 How long have you been a Winchester Public Schools teacher, administrator, or support staff member?

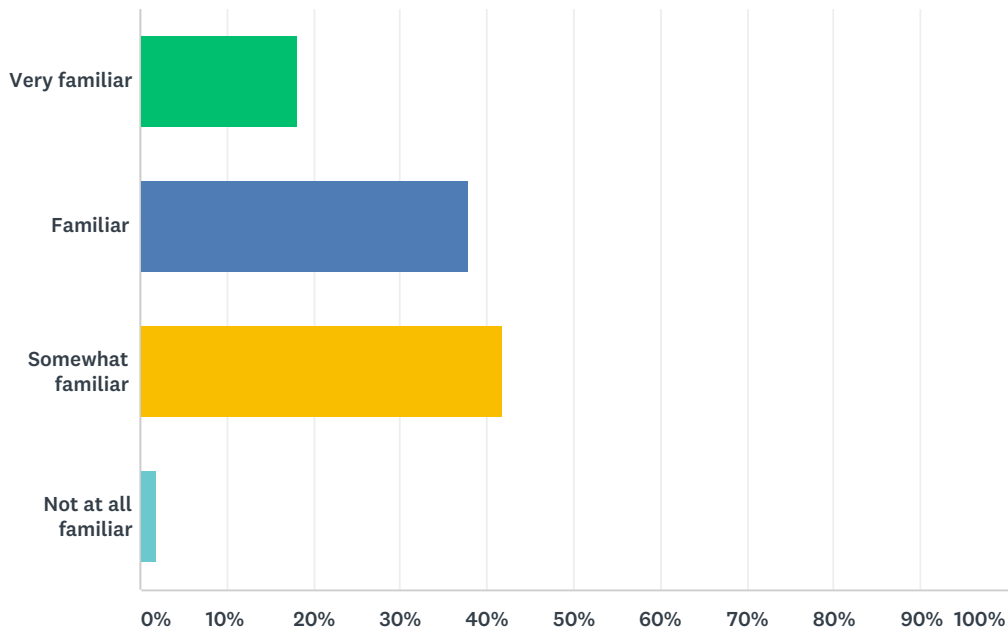

## Q2 How familiar are you with current research and discussion about changing middle and high school start times across the nation?

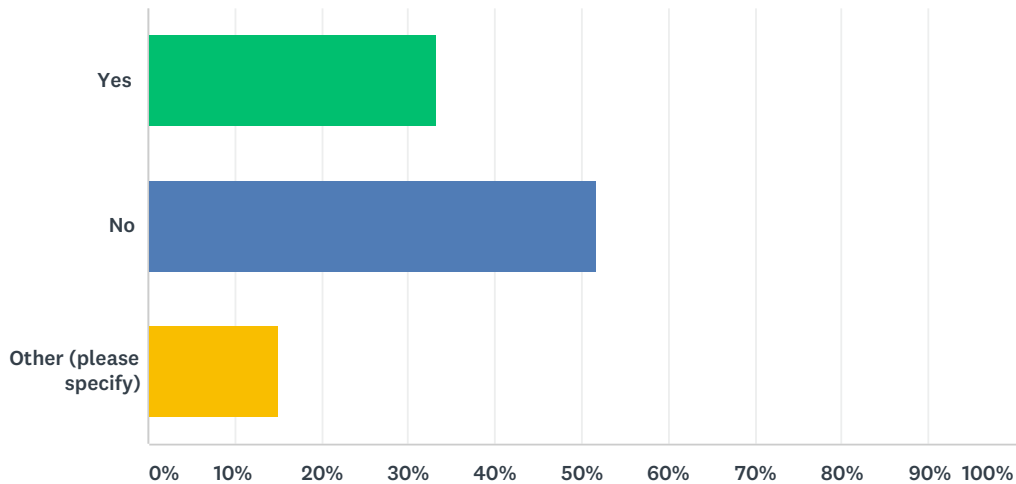

 (Please note: Middlesex League high schools have agreed to move toward an 8:30am start in the 2018-2019 school year.)**

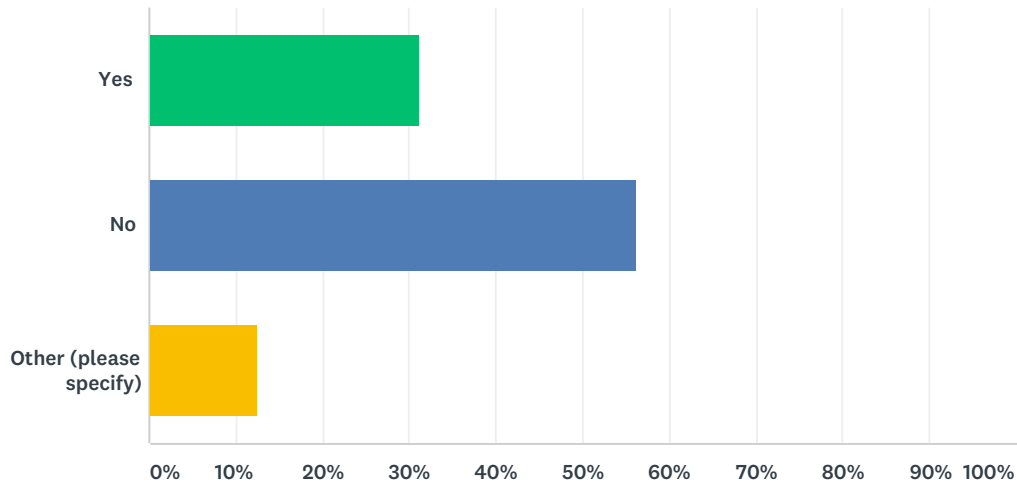

### Q4 As an educator, do you think that teachers and staff members would benefit academically, physically, and/or emotionally if elementary school started earlier?

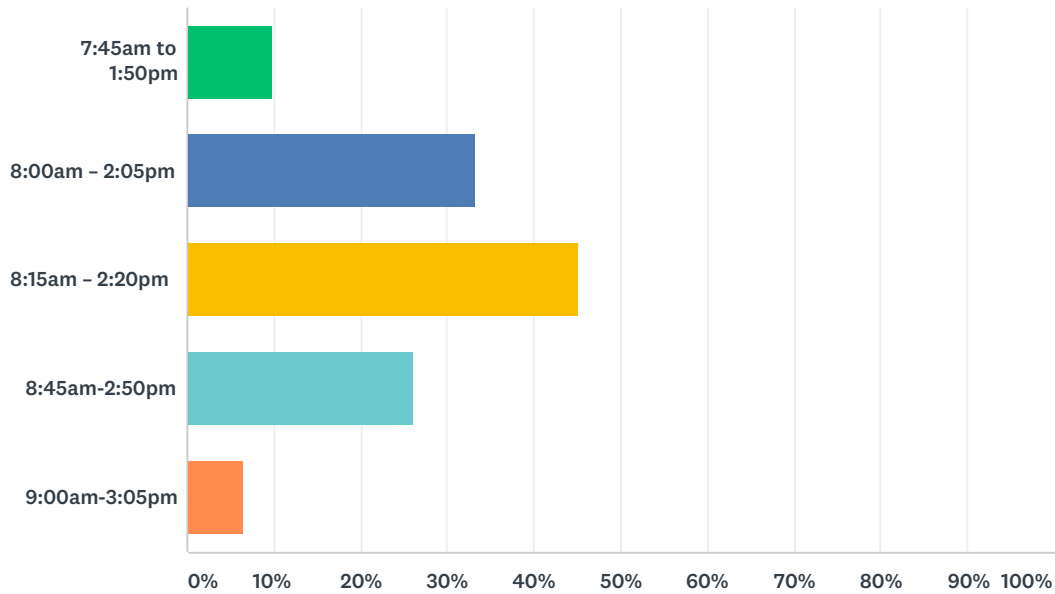

**Q5 Which of these possible schedules do you think would be best for students? Assume extracurricular activities and sports could be adjusted around these schedules:**

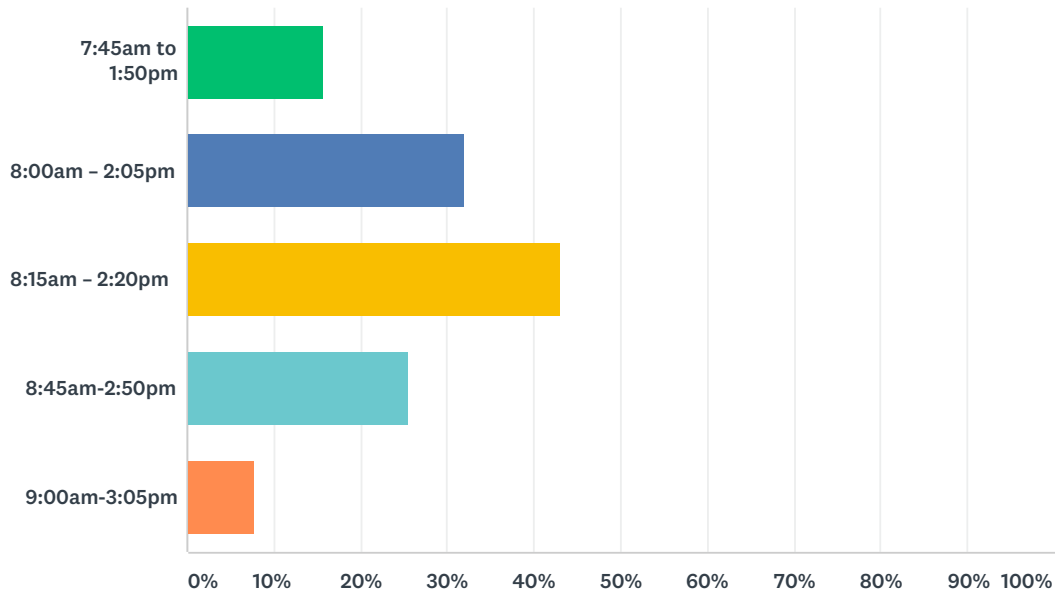

**Q6 Which of these possible schedules do you think would be best for you? (Assume extracurricular activities and sports could be adjusted around these schedules.)**

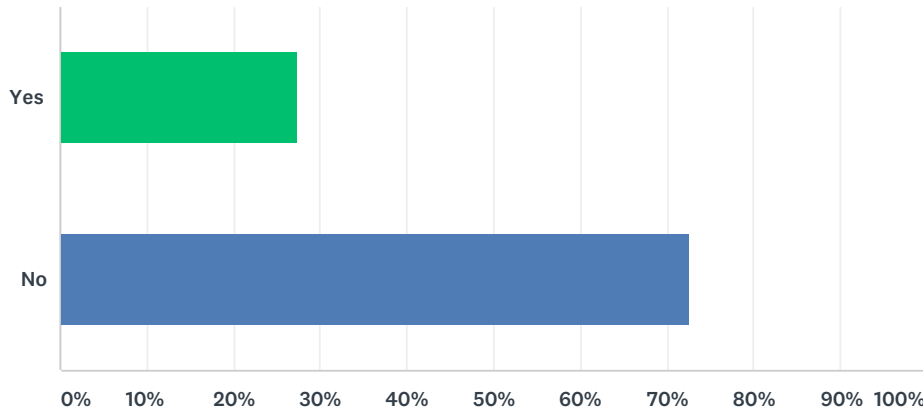

### Q7 Would an earlier school day conflict with a second job or child care for your family?

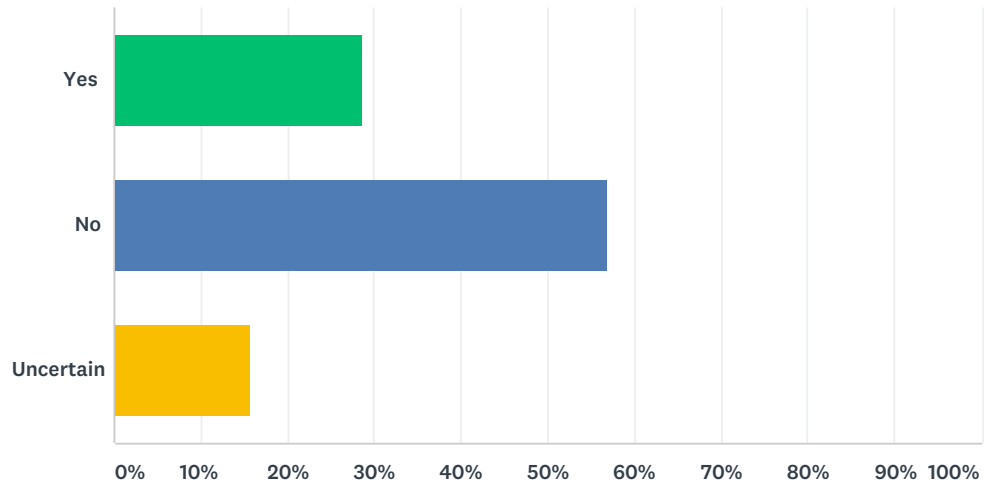

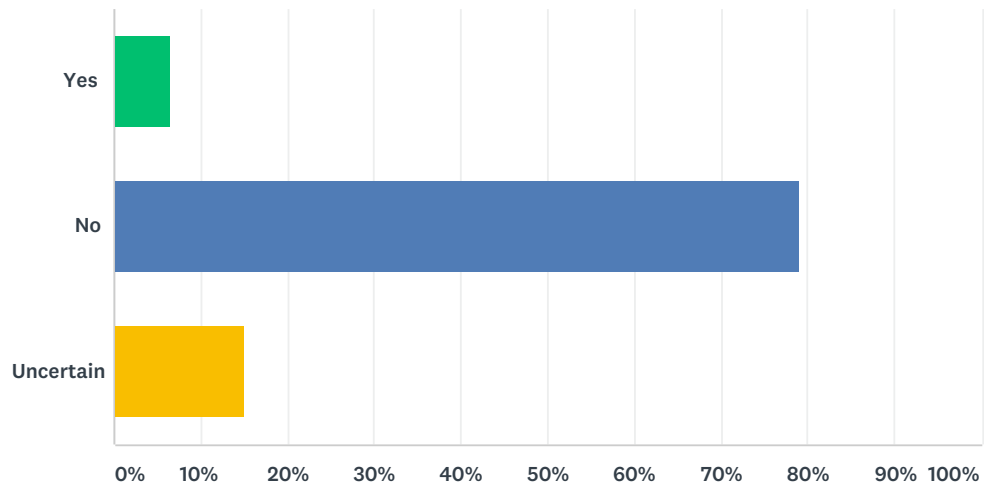

### Q9 Would an earlier school start time affect your ability to maintain a job teaching with the Winchester Public Schools?

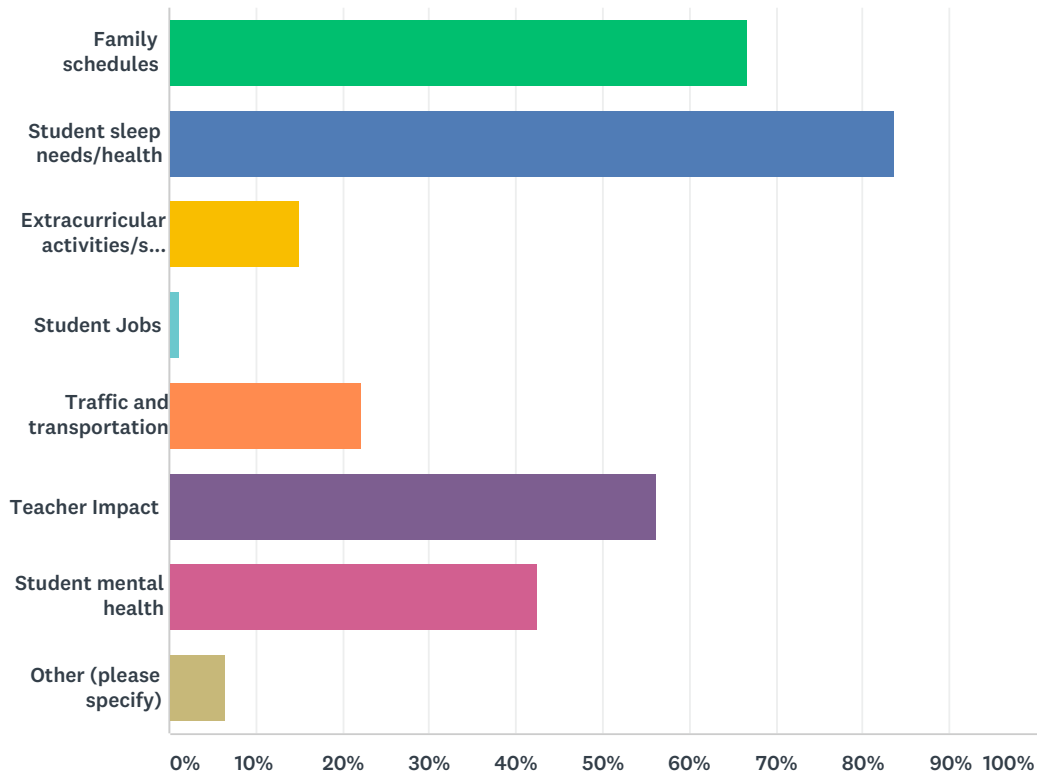

## Q10 Think back on the questions you answered in this survey regarding school start times. What are the top three factors that most influenced your choices?

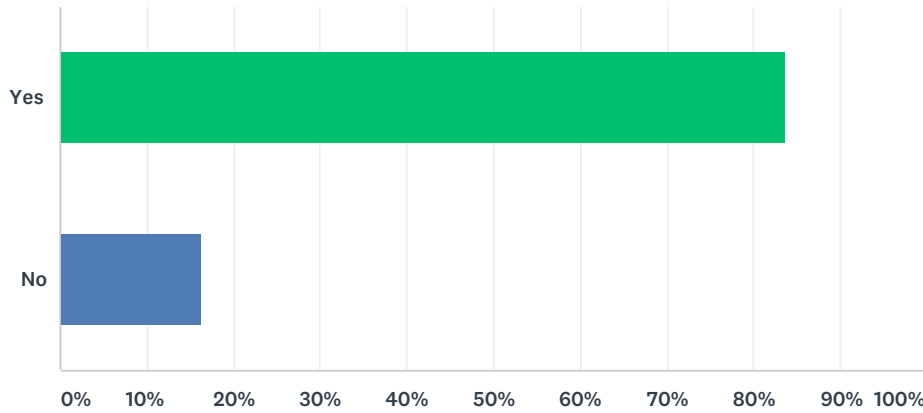
