Wrap-Around Care

Wrap-around care will be offered at all five elementary schools for students in grades K-5, both before and after school.

- The provider will be Winchester Recreation Department.
- Students may attend regularly (from 1-5 days per week), or on an as-needed basis with 24-48 hours' notice.
- Cost will be between \$8 and \$12 a session, depending on use.
- Provisions for low-income students will be made available.
- The morning session will run from 7:30 to 8:10 a.m. and the afternoon session from 2:20 to 4:00 p.m. For district-wide department/staff meetings, we may be able to extend the pick-up time upon request for WPS employees.
- Care will also be available on early release days.
- Registration will open on about 8/1/18 via the Recreation Department Website. All parents who plan to use wrap-around care should complete registration during August. We will send another notice to all parents when the registration forms are available.
- We are studying the possibility of offering full on-site extended day programs at each elementary schools until 6 p.m. for the 2019-2020 school year, depending on demand.
- No bus transportation home will be provided to students in the wraparound program.
- The program will begin during the first full week of school.
