NOTICE OF BIDS FOR: ATHLETIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES  
FOR THE WINCHESTER PUBLIC SCHOOLS

The Town of Winchester will receive sealed bids for the furnishing of school buses for transportation of students and other authorized persons to and from interscholastic athletic events, according to specified conditions. Bidders are invited to furnish the Winchester School Committee of the Town of Winchester with bids for ATHLETIC TRANSPORTATION Winter/Spring, 2019. A complete set of bid documents may be obtained from the Winchester School Department Administration Office, 40 Samoset Road, Winchester, MA 01890 or by calling the Director of Finance and Operations at 781-721-7000.

Bids will be accepted at the Office of the Superintendent of Schools, 40 Samoset Road, Winchester, MA 01890 until 11:00 a.m. on February 21, 2019 at which time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. The clock in the Superintendent's Office will serve as the official time. Bids shall be accepted only if received no later than Thursday, February 21, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. In hand, deliveries shall be accepted on business days between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. at the Office of the Superintendent of Schools. All bids must be submitted in duplicate, sealed and clearly marked "**ATHLETIC TRANSPORTATION BID**".

All bids are subject to the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 30b. No bidder may withdraw its bid within thirty days after the date designated above for the receipt of bids. The contract shall be awarded to the bidder who submits the lowest total responsible and responsive bid for this academic three-year contract, and who is determined by The Superintendent and/or School Committee, to be the most capable and reliable in providing athletic transportation to meet the needs of the students of the Winchester Public Schools.

The Winchester School Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, or any part thereof and to make such awards deemed to be in the best interest of the Town of Winchester.
